# *The Incredible Journey*

When you think of the water cycle, you often imagine a drop of water, flowing from a stream to an ocean, evaporating to the clouds, raining down on a mountaintop, and flowing back into a stream. Water does circulate from one state to another in the water cycle, but the path a drop of water can take is variable. Your poster will be a creation of the path that your drop of water takes during its' own incredible journey.

### **Ideas:**

- Water changes states, gas, liquid and solid, your drop can travel through the atmosphere and form in a cloud, land and turn into a glacier, which melts into the ocean.
- Water can flow through streams and rivers to tumbling oceans, it also travels underground, filtering through particles of soil and rocks.
- Water can also travel through plants and living organisms.

Poster contest is open to all Blair County Students, public, private and home schooled, grades K-12.
