2018 Blair County Poster Contest Rules

- The 2018 title, “Watersheds – Our Water Our Home” must appear on each poster.
- Posters will be judged in five categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-6, 7-9, and 10-12.
- Posters must be submitted on 11” x 17” (tabloid) size paper or 11” x 17” poster board.
- No artist’s name may appear on the front of the poster.
- All posters must include a completed poster contest form, TAPED NOT GLUED to the back of the poster. To protect student privacy, entry forms will be removed prior to display. Contest forms can be downloaded from the District’s website at www.blairconservationdistrict.org under the Educators tab beneath Quick Links.
- Only one poster will be accepted per student. Posters must be created by an individual student, not a team.
- Posters must be flat or two-dimensional. Oil, crayon, colored pencils, pastels, watercolors, etc. on appropriate paper or poster board, is acceptable. Photographic or digitally created art will NOT be accepted.
- Judging criteria:
 - Conservation Message Appropriate to Grade Level – 50%
 - Creativity/ Visual Appeal – 50%
- All entries must be received at the Blair County Conservation District office, 1407 Blair Street Hollidaysburg, PA 16648, by 4:00 PM, Friday, March 23rd.
- All entries may be displayed at the Logan Valley Mall the week prior to Earth Day, April 22nd.
- Student winners will be contacted through their teachers.
- Winners may be recognized at the Annual Blair County Earth Day Celebration at the Logan Valley Mall, to be held April 21st, 2018, 12:00pm at the stage in front of the JC Penney store.
- Posters that do not adhere to these rules will be disqualified.
