Summer Reading Program -Each year the Conservation District offers a Summer Reading program to match the current library summer reading theme.

What’s Hatching at your Library— Usually you “borrow” things from the library, but in this program the library borrow a glass dome incubator so patrons can watch baby chicks hatch! At around the 10th day of incubation, we “candle” the eggs to see which are fertile and do a program about chick development. As a special treat- meet one of the hens that laid the eggs.
